Dr. Susan O'Connell qualified with an honours degree in Medicine from University College, Dublin in 1998 and completed Paediatrics Higher Professional Training in Ireland in 2007. Since 2005 she has sub-specialised in Paediatric Endocrinology and she was awarded a Doctorate of Medicine (MD) in 2009 from Trinity College Dublin for her thesis on follow-up growth of children born small for gestational age (SGA). She spent 3 years on Fellowship in Princess Margaret Hospital, Perth Western Australia and was awarded FRACP in 2012. She returned to Ireland in 2012 as Consultant Paediatric Endocrinologist and spent 5 years

in Cork University Hospital before moving back to Dublin to CHI Crumlin Endocrinology in 2018.

Susan has a major interest in rare endocrine disorders, growth disorders and clinical genetics, and is the Paediatric Lead of the Irish membership of the ENDO-ERN (European Reference Networks).

She served on the NREC- MD (National Research and Ethics Committee - Medical Devices) from 2021-2024 and has recently been appointed to the CHI Clinical Ethics Service. She is also a member of the British Paediatric Surveillance Unit Scientific Committee and is Honorary Clinical Associate Professor at Royal College of Surgeons of Ireland.
